Frond from 3 to 9 inches or even a foot long, raised on a smooth hollow stalk, which tapers downwards; it consists of a sterile and a fertile branch, the former of which is leaf-like, broadly ovate or oblong, entire, from 2 to 3 inches long, narrowed at the base, and sheathing the fertile branch; fertile branch spike-like. Fructification in the form of a spike, about an inch long, on the apex of the fertile...
